

EXPLICATION AND EXPLANATION

Practice of Measures on COVID 19 In Accordance With The Cabinet Resolution Dated 17 March 2020 and Announcements of Provincial Communicable Diseases Committees

According to the Cabinet Resolution dated 17 March 2020 on measures and orders regarding COVID 19 and Announcements of the Provincial Communicable Disease Committees issued in compliance with the cabinet resolution.

The measure on temporary closure of some venues does only specify criteria of venues to be closed such as higher education institutions, schools, tutoring schools, boxing stadiums, sport stadiums, fitness centers, theatres, entertainment outlets established in accordance with Entertainment Place Act, venues where are similar to entertainment outlets, etc.

Such measure announced and enforced *does not prohibit the servicing or selling of alcoholic beverages at the venues where have not been ordered to close*, except venues where the selling of alcoholic beverages has been prohibited as prescribed by the Alcoholic Beverage Control Act.

Please be informed accordingly for your understanding and compliance with the cabinet resolution and announcements of the Provincials Communicable Diseases Committee.
